A) He was born in Liverpool, England in 1940. He wanted to be an artist. In 1962 he formed the band "The Beatles" with Paul McCartney, George Harrison and Ringo Star. He married Yoko Ono, a Japanese girl. The band divided in 1970. One of the greatest albums was "Let It Be". In 1975 John's and Yoko's son, Sean was born. On December 8, 1980, Mark Chapman, a young man, shot John outside his home in New York. John died in a police car on the way to the hospital.

B) Edison Arantes do Nascimento was born in October 25, 1914 in Brazil. He was the second of four children. He was a soccer player. He grew up in an extremely poor neighbourhood, where the only entertainment for a poor boy was to play soccer. He played for his first soccer team at the age of eleven. Some years later, Brazil took him to Santos where he became one of the best of that soccer team. In 1970 he played for Brazil's World Cup team and brought the title to the team. Then he played for the New York Cosmos of the North American Soccer League. In 1977 the Cosmos won the league championship and finally he retired after that victory.

C) He was born in San Francisco in 1955. He became interested in computers when he was a teenager and attended lessons after school at Hewlett Packard (HP). In 1974, he got a job as a technician at the video game maker Atari. He and Steve Wozniak founded Apple in 1976. They developed the Mac. It was the first small computer. He created Mac OS operating systems such as "Toy Story" and "Finding Nemo". His name has a connection to innovative products like the iPod, iTunes, iPhone and iPad. His attention to design, function and style won him a lot of fans. He died on October 2011 at the age of 56.

D) She was born in Almusina in 1910, and died in 1997. Her real name was Agnes Gonska Bajarathil. She became famous all over the world for starting the Missionaries of Charity in Calcutta, India. She started this work in 1980 and for over forty years, she looked after the poor, sick, orphaned, and dying. She won the Nobel Peace Prize in 1979 for her humanitarian work. She decided to become a nun when she was 12. She arrived in India in 1939 and became a nun two years later. In 1944, she received a call from God to leave the convent and help the poor. She was an international symbol of charity, visiting many countries to help poor children. After she died, the Pope started the process to make her a saint.

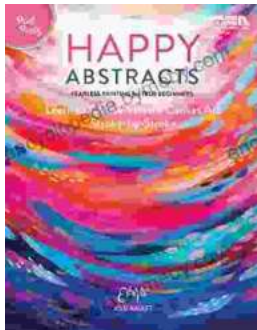
