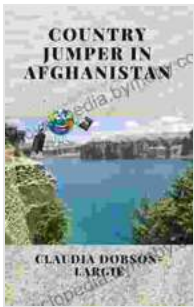


Country Jumper in Afghanistan: A Woman's Adventures in a War-Torn Nation

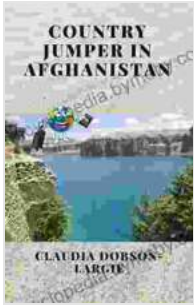

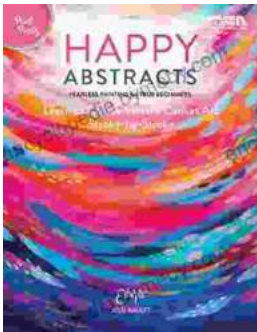
