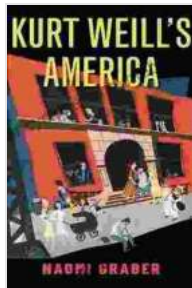


Kurt Weill in America: The Life and Work of a Musical Genius

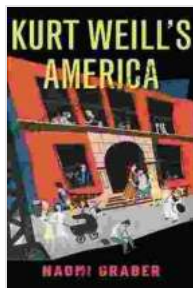

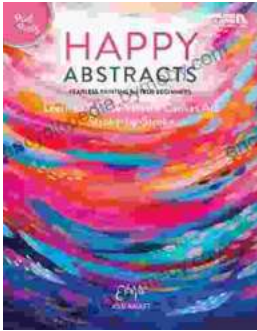
