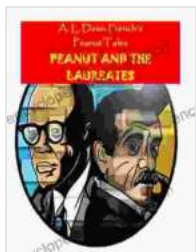

Peanut and the Laureates Activity Guide

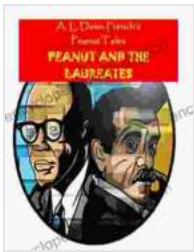
The following activity guide is designed to help children explore the themes of friendship, teamwork, and imagination in Peanut and the Laureates.
